FINAL EXAMS: What all Students NEED to Know

- Students MUST write their exam during the scheduled time. Please do not ask if exams can be moved for vacation, sports, travel, etc. This will not be approved. Students are expected to be available to write exams from January 25th through February 1st.
- If buses are canceled due to inclement weather, exams scheduled on that day will be rescheduled to the next exam day. Subsequent exams in the exam schedule will also be rescheduled to the next exam day
- If you have an exam conflict, please contact Ms. Yanch ASAP
- Students with accommodations will have them provided and explained prior to their exam.
- Grade 9 & 10 exams are maximum 1.5 hours in length. Grade 11 & 12 exams are maximum 2 hours in length.

- * Students who arrive late for their exam should report immediately to the attendance office.
- Students absent from an examination will be considered legitimate under the following circumstances: health reasons with a doctor's certificate or family emergency with parent / guardian note. Your parent/guardian must phone the school as soon as possible to report your absence. Expect to have your examination rescheduled to a different day in the conflict room.
- ~ Students should come prepared with their own supplies (calculator, pencil, pen, ruler, etc.). Students must leave
- backpacks, materials, electronics, etc., at the edges of the cafeteria or in their lockers.
- ~ Students must return their textbooks to the Library / Learning Commons during exam week.
- ~ The library and lower library will be **quiet** study areas. If you are in the school, you must be in study areas
